

Juene Syndrome

- Familial Asphyxiating Thoracic Dystrophy
- Juene 1955
- Rare 1 / 10⁵ live births
- Autosomal recessive acromelic dwarfism
- Variable severity reflects genetic heterogeneity
- Restrictive lung disease
- Renal / pancreatic disease
- Neonatal Juene Syndrome is fatal in 70 %


Locus at chromosome 15q13 Locus at 3q24-3q26

A chrondrodysplasia linked to a defect in primary cilia function or intraflagellar transport





Juene syndrome sciatic notch bone spikes


















Static sternal distraction




Rib distraction -osteogenesis










Dynamic thoracoplasty





"Dynamic Thoracoplasty"

- Life saving in the neonate with severe Jeune syndrome
- Gradual distraction avoids skin /wound problems
- X 10 increase in alveoli in the first 2 years of life
- Gradual distraction "grows the lung" not just the chest wall
- ? Applicable also in severe neonatal spinal deformity
