

Robert M. Campbell, Jr. Award for Innovation in Early Onset Scoliosis Nomination Form

The Campbell Award Nomination Forms for 2023 must be submitted by August 20, 2023.

The Campbell Award will honor a physician or scientist for outstanding contributions to the care of children with early onset scoliosis. Contributions would include innovative concepts, techniques, devices, or other major contributions which have significantly improved treatment outcomes for these patients with EOS. While any physician or scientist is eligible to receive the Campbell Award, special consideration will be given to senior thought leaders.

A plaque will be awarded, and the recipient's name announced at the Annual International Congress on Early Onset Scoliosis. The recipient is encouraged to attend the meeting as registration fees shall be waived. *Winners will receive hotel accommodations and complimentary program registration.* If the recipient is unable to attend the meeting due to health or other unusual circumstances, then a video connection will be allowed. Airfare for spouses/accompanying persons will not be reimbursed.

Sponsors must complete the nomination form by August 20, 2023 and return a copy of the nomination form to the recipient listed below. The winning nominee will be notified by September 6, 2023.

General Guidelines:

- Candidate must have made an exemplary and outstanding contribution to innovation and advancement of knowledge in the care of children with early onset scoliosis.
- Sponsor may independently send out requests for letters of support on behalf of the candidate.
- Sponsors must complete the 2023 Campbell Award Nomination Form to nominate a candidate. The Nomination Form is submitted as a pdf by e-mail. The Nomination Form pdf should be e-mailed to kjohnston@broad-water.com
- The candidate will be notified of his/her nomination within 1-2 business days. Recipient of the award will be notified by September 6, 2023.
- The award recipient must accept by completing and submitting the Acceptance Form by September 15, 2023.

NOTE: There are no limitations on the number of times a person may be nominated for the Campbell Award.
